#### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

#### 1. TITLE AND AUTHORITY

The meeting will be known as '2011 Avondale Club Rally' hereinafter referred to as 'The Event'. The Event will be a Club Rally and shall be run under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the National Rally Code, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations that may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au).

**2. PERMIT NUMBER: 511/0309/20**

#### 3. THE EVENT

The Event will be run as a Club Non-Special Stage, Road Section Rally as per the National Rally Code in the CAMS Manual. The event shall be held entirely on **private** property known as Avondale and Farmcote Stations on existing tracks. The Event will be approximately 165km competitive in length and 4.5km transport, held on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2011. Starting positions will be decided by Seeding/Ballot. Timing will be 'A-A' and to the ¼ **minute using time allowed, not elapsed time**. It will be a Day/Night Event. There will be 2 and 4 wheel drive classes.

## 6. TIMETABLE

Entries open upon release of these Supplementary Regulations.  
Close of Entries will be Thursday 1st September 2011 at 5.00pm.  
The start of the Event will be on Saturday 3rd September at 1.00pm, and the first car is expected to finish by 7.45pm.  
Crew briefing and issue of Route Instructions will be Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September at 12.30pm.

## 7. CANCELLATION OR ALTERATION

The Organisers reserve the right to abandon, postpone, cancel or modify the event due to reason of 'force majeure', in which case the provisions of the NCR59 shall apply. The Organisers reserve the right to abandon the Event if insufficient entries are received by close of entries. The maximum field is 30.

## 8. JUDGES OF FACT

All marshals and control officials are considered Judges of Fact as to whether a vehicle has correctly completed the course per NCR 181.

## 9. ENTRY

This is a closed Event and is only open to financial members of the Barrier Sporting Car Club Inc. Members of any other Clubs may purchase a one day BSCC membership at the cost of \$15.00 per Competitor. The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the NCR83. All competitors must have as a minimum, a current CAMS Clubman Rally/Navigator Licence, or Junior Rally Navigator Licence. The minimum co-driver or navigator age is 14yrs old.

An entry fee of \$140.00 will be charged per vehicle and must accompany entry form disclaimers. Cheques/money orders are to be made payable to the Barrier Sporting Car Club Inc.

## 10. PROTESTS

Any protests must be lodged according to the provision of part XII of the NCR's.

## 11. SCRUTINY

All vehicles must be presented for Scrutineering in a ready to rally condition. Vehicles will be inspected for general safety and compliance with eligibility regulations.

Scrutineering will be on Thursday 1st September from 5.00pm to 7.00pm at Baldwin Automotive, McGowan Street. Broken Hill. Interstate/Away competitors may be scrutineered in their own state by a CAMS accredited scrutineer, with a final document check on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September from 10.00am at Avondale Station.

## 12. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

Vehicles, to be eligible, must comply with the General Requirements for Rally Cars as well as the Specific regulations relevant to the status of the Event, and must comply with CAMS Schedule A regarding minimum safety equipment.

- a) All vehicles will need to be roadworthy and scrutineered.
- b) The Clerk of the Course may refuse any entry, if it is not in the best interest of the nature of the Event, without giving any reason (NCR83). The Event is a Car Rally, not an Off Road Event, e.g. Buggies will not be allowed to enter.
- c) Vehicles must have a front window in place as original and be laminated.

## 13. SAFETY

- 13.1 All Competitors must wear a helmet to a standard listed in Schedule D of the 2011 Manual of Motor Sport (AS 1698 or better), which is to be presented at scrutineering.
- 13.2 A safety harness of at least four point attachment must be worn at all times whilst competing.
- 13.3 All vehicles must carry a securely fitted fire extinguisher of at least 2.0kg capacity, or 2 by 1kg capacity, complying with Schedule H of CAMS manual. **Note:** Halon extinguishers (1201 or 1311, including BCF) are not permitted under civil legislation.

- 13.4 Neck to wrist to ankle non-flammable clothing must be worn.
- 13.5 All drivers must wear appropriate footwear.
- 13.6 Any driver who consumes, or is visibly affected by alcohol or drugs during the Event, shall be excluded from the Event and be dealt in accordance with the NCR's.

## 14. AWARDS

The Organisers reserve the right to nominate awards up to the start of the Event.

## 15. PACE NOTES

There will be **no pace notes** or practice **before** or **after** the Event.

## 16. CATERING

Catering will be provided on the day of the Event, including Lunch, Tea and Dinner.

## 17. PRESENTATION

Results and presentations will be made as soon as practicable at the conclusion of the Event.

## 18. ROAD BOOKS

Road books will be issued by the Organisers and will be fully route charted and will be run in accordance with the National Rally Code. Maps will be supplied by the Organisers.

## 19. DOCUMENTS

Documents to be presented at documentation include:

- Current CAMS Competitor Licence of BOTH crew members
- CAMS vehicle log book
- CAMS Affiliated Club Membership cards
- Vehicle registration papers if applicable
- All documents must be current and not expire over the duration of the Event.

## 20. FUEL AVAILABILITY/REFILLING

No fuel will be available at the Venue; entrants will be required to bring their own. Refilling will only be allowed in the service area. Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G. The greatest distance between servicing is approximately 80Km. Total distance of the Event is 170Km including transport.

## 21. SERVICING

Servicing will only be allowed in the designated service area adjacent to the big shed, Avondale Station, as per instructions.
